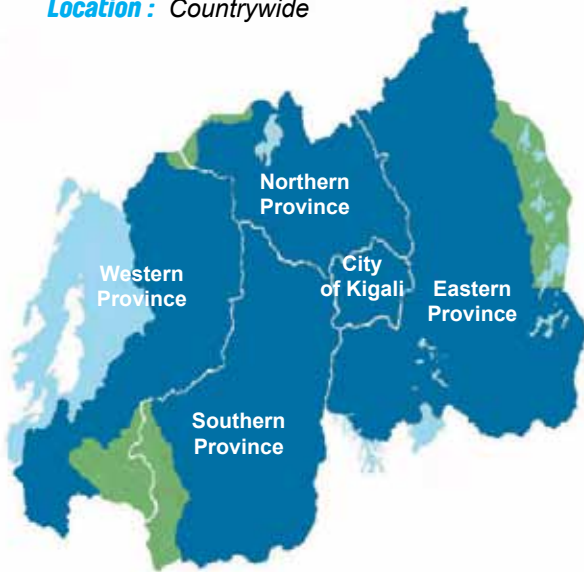

## BACKGROUND

Rwanda, currently among the fastest growing economies in Africa has a vision to become a middle income country by 2020. Key to achieving this is a reliable supply of electricity at prices that are both stable and regionally competitive. To ensure that the energy sector effectively contributes to the realization of national development goals, the Government of Rwanda has set specific targets for the energy sector, including

- An increase in generation capacity from 160 Mw to 563 Mw by 2018
- Access to electricity for 70% of all Rwandans by 2018

## WHO WE ARE

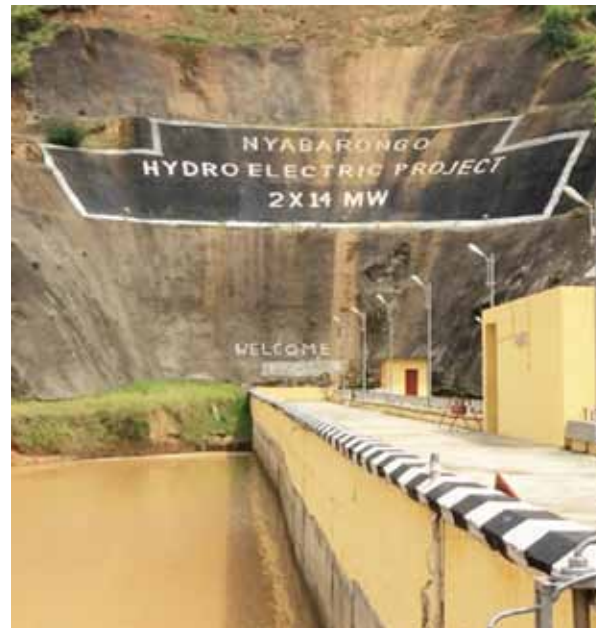

## WHAT WE DO

To achieve its goals, the project focuses on three areas:

### RELIABILITY

Develop technical capability of utility equipment and personnel with the goal of reducing blackout frequency and duration.



## MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS

Improve management access to real-time information required to make informed strategic, operational and financial decisions.



## PEOPLE

Develop human resources, management and planning capabilities to ensure high quality and motivated staff at EUCL who are dedicated to the achievement of organizational goals.
